Other information:

- 1. Applicants will be evaluated on academic performance, community service to Springfield, recommendations, and the benefits derived from the completion of your continuing education. Other evidence, such as demonstrating initiative, will also be considered.

- 3. Only one scholarship will be awarded to any individual.
- 4. The scholarship is worth \$1000 and will be limited to 5 individuals.
- 5. Trustees will review each applicant and select recipients at the May meeting.
- 6. Checks will be awarded in June.
- 7. Should a successful applicant not attend a program of higher education, trustees expect the scholarship gift to be returned to the library.
